

SPEAKERS:

We welcomed 50 speakers, marking a remarkable 194.1% increase. These individuals, hailing from various industries and backgrounds, shared their experiences, expertise, and visions for a more inclusive future.

REGISTRANTS:

Registrations soared to 2,876, a substantial 79.8% increase. This growth underscores the expanding interest and commitment to Black Inclusion Week's mission. The surge in registrations reflects a growing awareness and desire among individuals and organisations to engage in conversations about race, inclusion, and equity. It also highlights the effectiveness of our outreach and promotional efforts, which successfully attracted a diverse and engaged audience eager to participate in this pivotal event.



ATTENDEES:

We welcomed 1,695 attendees, more than doubling last year's numbers with a 126% increase. This turnout demonstrates the growing community eager to engage in these vital conversations.

In a world increasingly connected by digital threads, Black Inclusion Week 2024 harnessed the power of social media to amplify its message and foster a global community dedicated to inclusion. The digital wave of inclusion surged higher than ever, reflecting growing interest and active participation across platforms.



- **Impressions:** "A remarkable reach that speaks volumes." Black Inclusion Week 2024 garnered 54,534 impressions, an astounding increase of 10,189.4%. This dramatic rise highlights the event's extensive reach and the effectiveness of our digital strategy in capturing the attention of a wide audience. These impressions indicate that our message was seen by tens of thousands, significantly raising awareness about the importance of Black inclusion.
- **Engagements:** "Meaningful interactions driving the conversation forward." The event recorded 4,835 engagements, up 37,092.3%. These engagements, which include likes, shares, and comments, show a deep level of interest and active participation from our audience. This surge in interactions reflects the community's eagerness to engage with our content and be part of the dialogue on inclusion.






IMPACTFUL ENGAGEMENT

Demographic Breakdown

- **Black Heritage:** 67% of participants identified as being of Black heritage, reflecting the primary focus of the event on Black inclusion.
- **Non-Black Allies:** 15% of participants were non-Black allies, highlighting the importance of solidarity and support from all communities in the fight for racial equity.
- **Prefer Not to Say:** 18% of participants chose not to disclose their racial background.



The Black Inclusion Week 2024 served as a powerful catalyst for change among non-Black allies, providing them with crucial insights and transformative experiences.



Impact of the Events



Organisations that engaged with Black Inclusion Week recognised the value of a diverse workforce and the importance of Black inclusion in creating a fair and innovative corporate culture. Over 200 organisations participated in the week, reflecting a broad spectrum of industries, including finance, healthcare, education, transportation, marketing, and law enforcement. Notable organisations whose employees attended include HSBC, Family Action, NHS England, West Mercia Police, Spectra Marketing, National Police Chiefs Council, Arriva, and King's College Hospital.

These organisations sent their employees to various events, where they were provided with practical tools and strategies to enhance their diversity, equity, and inclusion (DE&I) initiatives. The week's events empowered attendees to bring back valuable insights and actionable steps to their workplaces, fostering more inclusive practices.

Across Industries

Black Inclusion Week 2024 spurred essential conversations on systemic changes required to address racial disparities across multiple industries. The representation spanned finance, healthcare, education, law enforcement, and marketing, among others. The diversity within these sectors in terms of Black colleagues varies, but all face significant challenges in achieving true equity and inclusion.

The finance industry, represented by companies like HSBC and euNetworks, and the healthcare sector, with organisations such as NHS England and King's College Hospital, saw considerable participation. These industries, along with others present, typically struggle with underrepresentation of Black professionals in leadership roles.




